From the north

Exit A1 at J43 onto M1 (London, Leeds). Leave M1 at J36. Follow A61 Sheffield. Tankersley Manor is half a mile on the left.

From the south

Travelling north on the M1 exit at Junction 36. Follow A61 Sheffield. Tankersley Manor is half a mile on the left.

From the east

From M18, join the M1 north (Sheffield/Leeds). Leave M1 at J36. Follow signs for Sheffield. Tankersley Manor is half a mile on the left.

From the west

From M62, exit at J29, (J42 of the M1). Leave M1 at J36. Follow A61 (Sheffield). Tankersley Manor is half a mile on the left.
